#### Update from VDH - Dr. Richard Williams, District Director

Dr. Williams provided updated information on the COVID-19 pandemic. There is a pandemic surge in Virginia at this point. The CDC school indicators are currently at high at-risk level. Dr. Williams stated the vast majority of outbreaks are due to community transmissions. Westmoreland County is in the highest risk category at this time. Dr. Williams stated he feels it is safe to keep kids in the hybrid learning role with all PPE requirements in place. He stated that with the holidays approaching more travel will occur and they anticipate higher numbers in January. Vaccination efforts in the three rivers district will begin next week.
