The Westmoreland County School Board met in regular session on Monday, April 19, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. at the Gerald B. Roane Center for Excellence Building, Montross, Virginia.

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Fallin, Chair.

### **Health Insurance Credit**

Dr. Perry recommended for the Board to approve the Virginia Retirement System Enhanced Health Insurance Credit (EHIC) For Non-Teacher Retirees.

Dr. Wallace made a motion to approve the following resolution as presented. Ms. Lane seconded the motion.

WHEREAS, localities may elect to provide, for employees of a local school division who are not teachers as defined in § 51.1- 124.3 of the *Code of Virginia*, an additional health insurance credit of \$1 per year for each full year of the retired member's creditable service, the costs of which shall be borne by the locality;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. The Westmoreland County School Board (the "Employer") hereby irrevocably elects to provide an additional health insurance credit of \$1 per year of creditable service as provided in § 51.1-1402.1(B) of the *Code of Virginia* as applicable for its eligible current and future retired employees who are not teachers as defined in § 51.1-124.3 of the *Code of Virginia*; and
- 2. The Employer elects to allow its eligible retirees who are not teachers as defined in § 51.1-124.3 to receive the enhanced health insurance credit for school divisions effective the first day of July, 2021; and
- 3. The Employer agrees to accept all liability for any current or future additional employer contributions and any increases in current or future employer contribution rates resulting from its election to provide the benefits of the enhanced health insurance credit for school divisions for its current and future retirees who are not teachers as defined in § 51.1-124.3.

NOW, THEREFORE, the officers of Employer are hereby authorized and directed in the name of Employer to carry out the provisions of this resolution and to pay to the Treasurer of Virginia from time to time such sums as are due to be paid by Employer for this purpose.
