The Westmoreland County School Board met in regular session on Monday, April 17, 2023 at 6:00 p.m. at the Gerald B. Roane Center for Excellence Building, Montross, Virginia.

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Fallin, Chair.

Statement of Mission and Statement

Dr. Wallace read the Westmoreland County Public Schools' mission and vision statements to the public.

Approval of Agenda

The agenda was approved by unanimous consent.

Delegations/Presentations

Attendance Recognition

Dr. Perry shared the attendance recognition for March. The school with the highest student attendance was Montross Middle School with an average percentage present of 95.33%.

Character Trait Honorees

Ms. Rice presented the Character Trait honorees for the month of March and the trait of Perseverance. Students recognized this month included Yassary Hernandez-Montes in grade four at Cople Elementary School; Micaela Mendez in grade four at Washington District Elementary School; Jenni Koontz in grade eleven at Westmoreland High School; and Brayon Wilson in grade eight at Montross Middle School.

Bus Driver Recognition

Mr. Rich, Transportation Supervisor, recognized bus drivers who set and achieved goals in regards to discipline on the school bus with minimum assistance from school administration. The drivers recognized were James Page, Cople Elementary School; Harold Dickerson, Washington District Elementary School; and Albert Henry, Montross Middle and Westmoreland High Schools. Mr. Rich shared a picture of the drivers.

Virginia Department of Health Update

Dr. Richard Williams presented an update on the pandemic. He shared that things are much better than they were a year ago. The number of cases per day is decreasing. Approximately 63% to 64% of the residents in Westmoreland County have been vaccinated. Dr. Williams stated that the Emergency Declaration will expire on May 11th. But, he told Board members and administration that if they need him, just call.

Washington District Science Bowl

Mr. Bathgate shared that students at Washington District have been participating in a tournament style science trivia game to help increase their SOL scores. Students were given questions and answers to approximately 500 SOL type questions for eighth graders. The game was interactive and challenging. Students enjoyed the game and were supportive of their classmates.

Cople Second Grade Zoologists

Ms. Steele shared that second graders at Cople Elementary have been working hard on integrating concepts in Science and Social Students during their literacy block. This project covered several SOLs. Students decided that they wanted to be Zoologists. Students researched the animal they chose, its habitat, diet, adaptations, life cycle and many other interesting facts. Students created a book using information they had researched and pictures they drew.

Information Items

School Nutrition Program (SNP) Excess Balance Corrective Action Plan Approval Dr. Perry shared that the excess balance corrective action plan was approved by the Virginia Department of Education Office of School Nutrition Programs.

The Board of Supervisors approved the resolution to move \$200,000 from the fund balance to the current budget. The Board of Supervisors asked if there was a plan for spending the funds. Dr. Perry shared that there is an approved plan from VDOE for the funds. The funds will be used to; 1. purchase equipment and other items for the cafeterias, 2. to bring the nutrition program into compliance and 3. to upgrade our cafeterias.

Virginia Literacy Act

Ms. Rice shared that the General Assembly unanimously approved the Virginia Literacy Act. The VLA is needed to reverse the trends in literacy levels, address learning loss from the pandemic, ensure all children read at benchmark at K-3, provide support for increasing numbers of at-risk readers and to provide resources for the teachers. A power-point was used to share these goals in detail.

Facility Report

Dr. Perry shared the amount of money currently on hand and the amount of money that will be needed to complete some of the major projects at Westmoreland High School. Updates on items completed during the spring break were also shared.
